Welcome to John C. Haines Middle School! We hope that you have a wonderful summer and come back well-rested and prepared for a school year that will be both challenging and exciting. To ensure that you will be equipped for a successful year, we are requesting that you arrive on the first day of school **Tuesday, September 5, 2017** with the following supplies:

- 5 – single-subject composition books including at least one of each of the following colors:
 - QUAD RULED-Mathematics (composition)
 - Blue-Social Science (composition)
 - Green-English/Writing (composition)
 - Red -Reading (composition)
 - Black-Science (composition)
- 5– pocket folders with prongs for each class (Use color scale above) yellow for mathematics
- 1 - 1 in. binders
- 2 – packs of loose-leaf notebook paper
- 1 – pack of 1 inch graph paper
- 4 – **black** ink pens & 2 **red** ink pens
- 4 - #2 pencils sharpened
- 1 – package of 4x5 index cards (lined)
- 1 – small stapler and small staples
- 1 – pack of sticky notes (post-its)
- 2 – yellow or pink highlighters
- 1 – box of colored pencils
- 3 container Clorox Wipes
- 1- compass (with cm/in markings)
- 1- clear protractor (with ruler markings)
- 3 – roll of paper towels
- 1 – bottle of hand soap
- 1 – bottle of hand sanitizer (non alcoholic)
- 1 – pencil sharpener with cover
- 1 – white-out pen
- 1 – standard-sized ruler with both centimeter (30 cm) and inch (12 in.)
- 1 – lock for your lockers
- 4 – boxes of tissues (1 is for art class)
- Chicago Public Library Card
- 1 roll Clear Scotch Tape
- Haines gym shirt and white or green shorts/exercise pants
- Arrangements to have access to a computer and printer**
- 1 pack of markers for projects
