Reading

We are continuing to practice blending and reading words up to 7 letters. We are focusing more on memorizing sight words and reading word family words (cat, bat, rat, sat, etc). We are learning how to make predictions before and during reading. We are continuing to focus on identifying key details in stories (such as problem and solution) and sequencing events.

Writing

We have been learning about opinion writing. Students are learning how to write an opinion and state a reason to support that opinion. Students will be working on spelling sight words correctly when writing and using word families and rhyme to help them spell unknown words. We are continuing to segment and record as many sounds as we can when writing unknown words (at least beginning, middle, and ending sounds). We are also continuing to work on other types of writing as well, such as informational writing (All About Writing and How-To Writing) and narrative writing (story writing).

Math

We are continuing working on addition and subtraction facts and word problems. In addition and subtraction, students will develop fluency for facts to 10 as well as on composing and decomposing numbers to 10.

Reminders

Continue to check back as new items are added weekly and bi-weekly. Remember to turn in completed reading logs by the 1st of the following month. Have students visit Raz-kids.com, and Superkids Online weekly after homework for extra practice and extension.
