

Greetings Families and Friends of Haines,

We hope this finds you well and ready to 'March' into Women's Month! Staff at Haines is always working to ensure our students arrive and depart school safely and timely.

Many of you may have noticed the 'No Left Turn' sign on the barricades placed during arrival and dismissal on the corner of West 23rd Place and Wentworth Avenue. This was a policy recommended and agreed upon by both the neighboring schools and the Alderman's office some years ago with the intent to ease traffic for Haines School, St. Therese School, and Pui Tak Christian School.

While we may not be able to enforce this rule, we do ask that all parents and families do their part in ensuring this policy is adhered to. The crossing guards provided by the Office of Emergency Management are charged with ensuring student safety only. While in the past they have assisted in enforcing this policy to assist Haines, they will no longer attempt to enforce this rule as the practice was not consistent, nor their responsibility.
