# FEBRUARY

### English

5th/6th graders students will explore literary genres by completing a series of genre studies. The concept of genres is introduced through class discussion and a group project. Students continue to read the novel Wonder to review figurative language, compare and contrast, and using evidence to support their claims.

7th/8th grade students will continue to study Vocabulary weekly and assessed on how well they apply those words in context through both formal and informal assessments. Students still continue to read the novel, Seedfolks in which the students will learn how to understand people from different cultural perspectives along with integration of different reading strategies/skills and writing skills.

### Math

5th/6th graders will learn Understand and Use Percent and continue to review decimal and fraction number operations.

7th/8th grade students will CONTINUE to study the unit on data and statistics with different types of graphs and solving algebraic expressions.

### Social Science

5th/6th graders will learn the map skills along with reading the nonfiction text, Who Was Sacagewea? as she traveled with the Lewis and Clark expedition.
