We will begin Math Topic 6 on subtraction fluency within 100. Students will learn to regroup 1 Ten for 10 ones and to use models to subtract 2-Digit and 1-Digit Numbers.



Science

This week, students continue to investigate the question, *Why can't plants always get the sunlight and water they need to grow?* As they explore a city park and a desert habitat in a digital app, students engage with the idea that seeds cannot grow in areas where they are competing with other plants' roots for water or in areas where they cannot get enough sunlight because they are blocked by other plants' leaves.
